Teaching Primary Social Studies (History, Geography and Social Studies)

This course consists of the components which make up Primary Social Studies, these are History, Geography and Citizenship. This course will deal with the methodology and objectives of teaching Primary history – 'New History' as a teaching approach, use of evidence, focus on key historical concepts and skills like for example the skill of empathy and the concept of time, role play, history outside the classsroom, games and simulation in history teaching. There are also suggestions as to ways of developing and implementing sound geographical work in practice. There is a critical appraisal of citizenship education and how civics can help teachers develop primary school children's understanding of social justice, global responsibility and human rights.

This course will look at the following themes: Schemes of Work, Integrating subjects, Differentiated Teaching, Teaching in an Inclusive Setup/Multicultural Approach and ICT using examples from Religion and Social Studies
