This war is unjust and irrational and causes unimaginable and unnecessary suffering to all individuals who are involved in this war. We therefore ask for immediate stop of the military aggression and for resumption of diplomatic negotiations.

We wish to express our deep solidarity with our colleagues and friends in Ukraine and we hope to continue and strengthen the cooperation as history educators, as researchers and as citizens of the free and sovereign countries within the broader European Community, where we can hopefully live and work together soon in freedom, human dignity and peace!
